The event took place on 25 May at the Lyon Resistance Museum in France, and was organized as part of the 'Resistance through their Eyes' project, co-organized by the LRE Foundation, the Resistance Museum, the Home Army Museum, the White Rose Foundation, the City of Milan, and the Ferruccio Parri National Institute.					
The seminar titled "Exploring Resistance During the Second World War: A Comparative Approach", held during a three-day workshop, provided a comparative perspective on resistance movements across Europe during World War II. It welcomed representatives from museums, institutions, organizations, and associations engaged in World War II studies and interested in the theme of resistance. During the seminar, participants explored the challenges and opportunities of studying and presenting resistance to the public. The sessions facilitated dialogue and information exchange among historians, academics, and practitioners in the field of resistance studies. The seminar successfully achieved its objective of providing a comparative perspective on resistance movements.					
In addition to the seminar, the workshop allowed project partners to address implementation issues and finalize the structure and content of the travelling exhibition, which will be presented in various languages. The exhibition will serve as an educational tool to disseminate knowledge about resistance during World War II.
